"And He said, "Certainly I will be with you." Exodus 3:12

Before I formed YOU in the womb I knew you, and before you *were* born I consecrated you; I have appointed you a prophet to the nations," Then I said, 'Alas, Lord God, Behold, I do not know how to speak. because I am a youth.'" But thanks be to God, Who in Christ always leads us in triumph [as trophies of Christ's victory] and through us spreads *and* makes evident the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere, <sup>15</sup> For we are the sweet fragrance of Christ [which exhales] unto God, [discernible alike] among those who are being saved *and* among those who are perishing: <sup>16</sup> To the latter it is an aroma [wafted] from death to death [a fatal odor, the smell of doom]; to the former it is an aroma from life to life [a vital fragrance, living and fresh]. And who is qualified (fit and sufficient) for these things? [Who is able for such a ministry? We?] <sup>17</sup> For we are not, like so many, [like hucksters making a trade of] peddling God's Word [shortchanging and adulterating the divine message]; but like [men] of sincerity *and* the purest motive, as [commissioned and sent] by God, we speak [His message] in Christ (the Messiah), in the [very] sight *and* presence of God. 2 Cor. 2:14-17 (AMP)

Therefore, I am well content with weaknesses, with insults, with distresses with persecutions, with difficulties, for Christ's sake: for when] art. weak, then I am strong. 2 Cor. 12:1B

For indeed He was crucified because of weaknesses, *yet* He lives because of the power of God. For we also are weak in Him. *yet* we shall live with Him because of the power of God directed toward you. 2 Cor. 13:4
